Hello Gurpreet, Harkirat, Peter, and Mayor Patrick,

Our neighborhood (Between the **countryside / mayfield** and along the **gorden randle** drive in Brampton) has serious concerns with the proposed change of zoning in our community.

Our community is on both sides of gorden randle drive (between countryside - mayfield) and only has 50', 60', 70' lots. There are two parks, ravine on both sides. When we bought our houses here six years ago, we paid extra \$100,000 for each house (more than for same houses nearby) to make sure there will be not small houses, no schools, and no plaza...

Recently we learnt that in the small empty space right in the middle of this executive community, the developer is planning to build high density Townhouses ... This is unacceptable. This empty space was approved to make similar 50', 60', 70' houses till recently. This change in our community zoning is not acceptable and not ethical. For many years, this empty space for zoned for similar large houses.

Please support us to STOP these developer's plans to ruin the look of this community.

Townhouses can be build somewhere else in Brampton, BUT not in this community. Townhouses in between these large houses will be disgrace. Also, there are no proposed schools and plaza in community so townhouses dont make sense here. We have expensive homes and pay lot of property tax to the city to live in this high price community.

We strongly object to this proposal of high density town houses in our community. Looking for our elected representative and city of Brampton.

We were told there is a review meeting on **Monday, June 20** in city council of Brampton
