APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIANCE

WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by VIKRAM SURAVARAPU, RASHIDA NARAHARA SETTI AND SWETHA SALIAN under Section 45 of the Planning Act, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from By-law 270-2004;

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described as Lot 27, Plan 43M-1262 municipally known as **44 RIBBON DRIVE**, Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicants are requesting the following variance(s):

- 1. To permit a below grade entrance between the main wall of a dwelling and the flankage lot line whereas the by-law prohibits below grade entrances between the main wall of a dwelling and a flankage lot line;
- 2. To permit an exterior side yard setback of 1.8m (5.91 ft.) to a below grade entrance whereas the by-law requires a minimum exterior side yard setback of 3.0m (9.84 ft.);
- 3. To permit an existing accessory structure (shed) to be located in the exterior side yard whereas the bylaw does not permit an accessory structure to be located in an exterior side yard;
- To permit 0.0m of permeable landscaping adjacent to the side line whereas the by-law requires a minimum of 0.6m (1.97 ft.) of permeable landscaping adjacent to the side lot line.
- 5. To permit a 3.75m (12.30 ft.) separation distance between a driveway and the point of intersection of two streets whereas the by-law requires a minimum 5.0m (16.40 ft.) separation distance between a driveway and projected point of intersection of two streets.

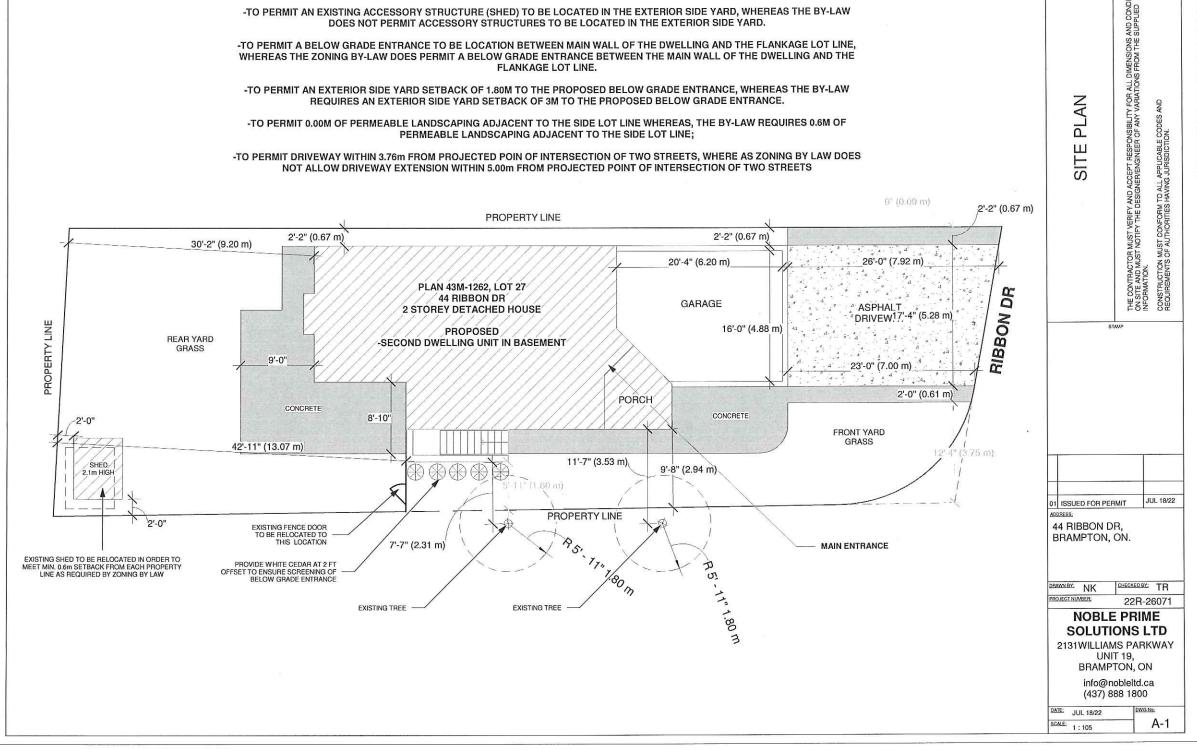

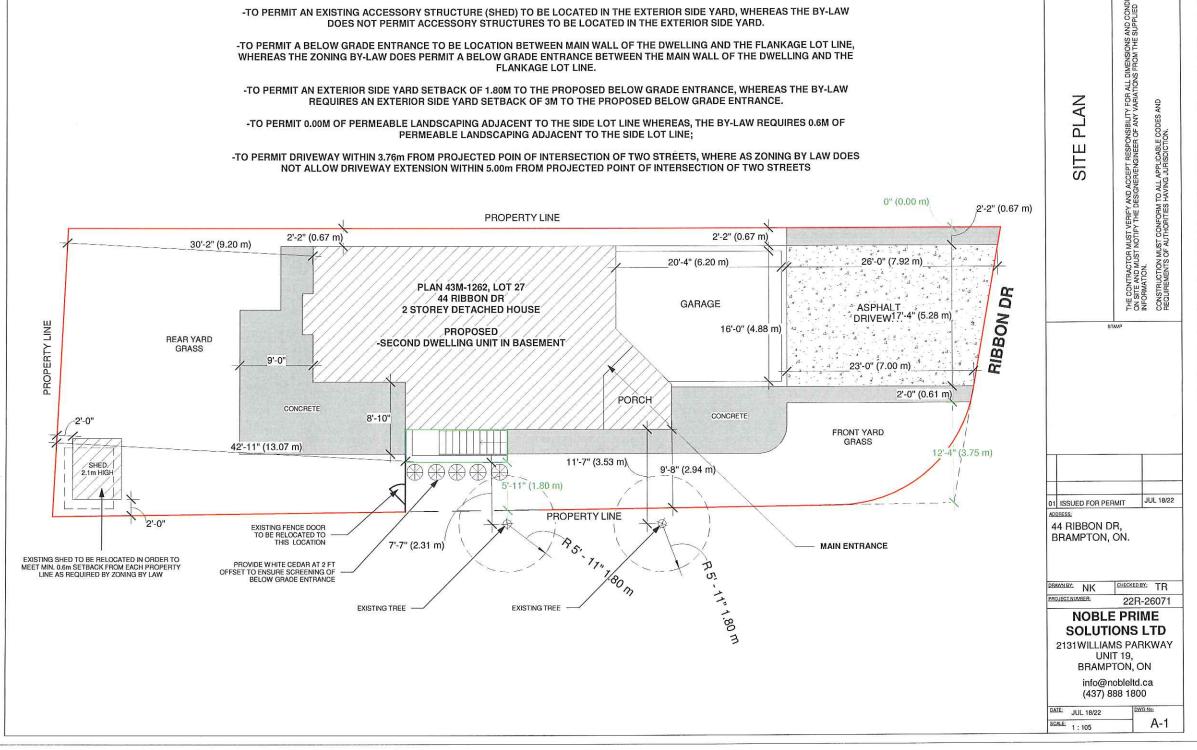
