1. To permit a parking space depth of 4.28m (14.04 ft.) whereas the by-law requires a minimum parking space depth of 5.4m (17.72 ft.).

This will also entitle you to be advised of an Ontario Land Tribunal hearing. 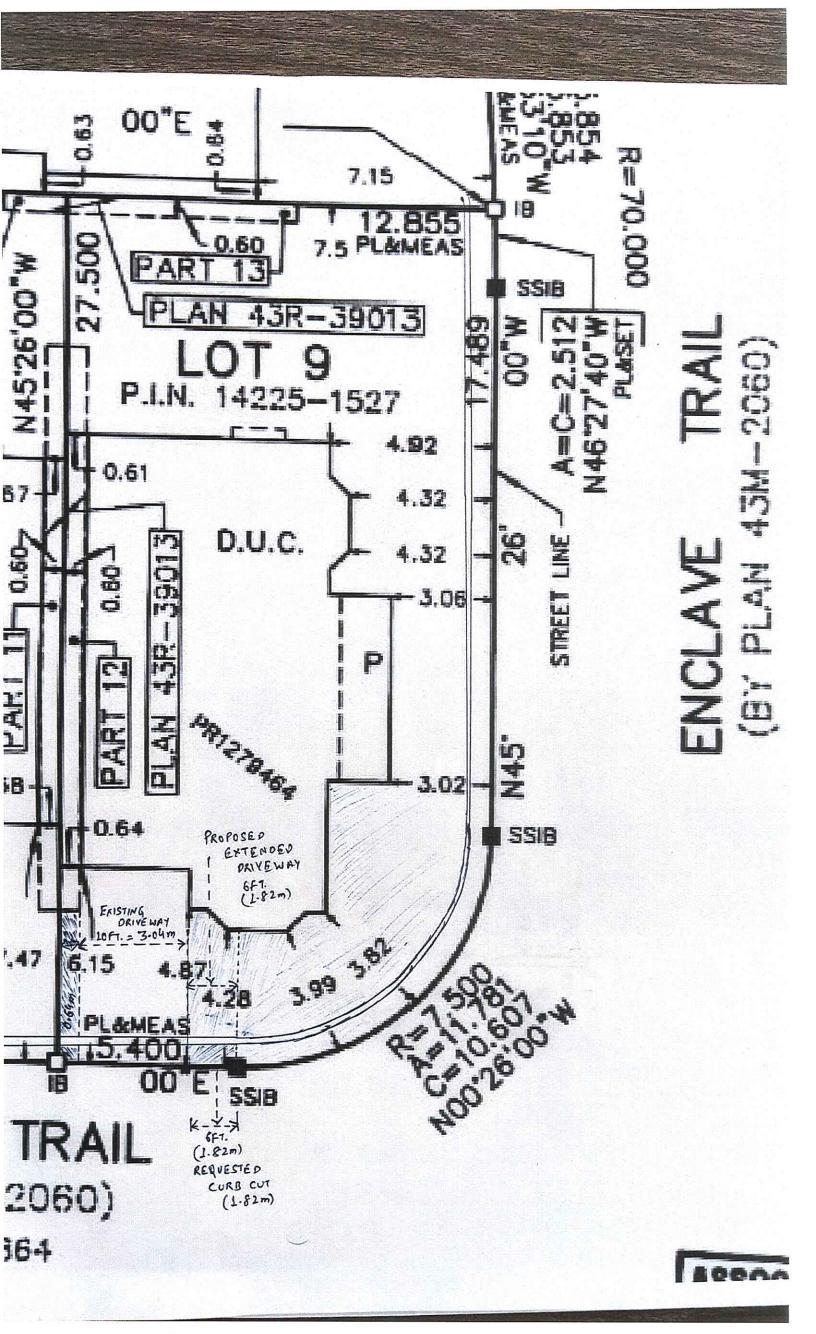

All written comments (by mail or email) must be received by the Secretary-Treasurer no later than 4:30 pm, Thursday, September 8, 2022.

- Advance registration for applicants, agents and other interested persons is required by one or two options:

 you with further details.

You will be contacted by the City Clerk's Office before the hearing date to confirm your attendance. Confirmation of in-person attendance will be subject to any in-person capacity limits that may be in place for Council Chambers at City Hall and prevailing public health orders and guidance.

If a party does not submit a request and does not participate in the hearing, the Committee may proceed without a party's participation and the party will not be entitled to any further notice regarding the proceeding.
