DEFERRED APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIANCE

WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by **JACK SZYDLOWSKI AND JOHANNA SZYDLOWSKI** under Section 45 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from **By-law 270-2004**;

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described as Lot Block A, Plan BR-24 municipally known as **6 BIRD AVENUE**, Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicants are requesting the following variance(s):

1. To permit a roof to encroach 6.04m (19.82 ft.) into the rear yard, resulting in a rear yard setback of 1.46m (4.80 ft.) whereas the by-law permits a roof to encroach a maximum of 2.0m (6.56 ft.), resulting in a rear yard setback of 5.5m (18.04 ft.).

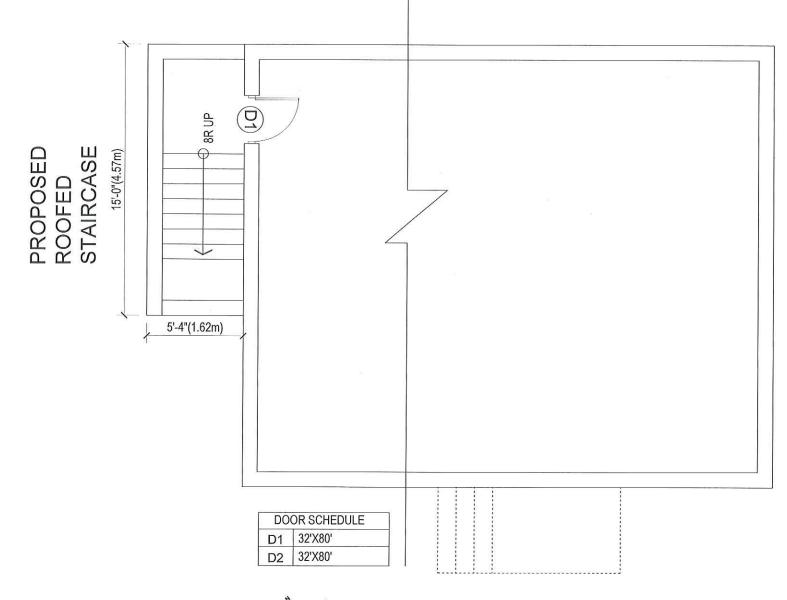

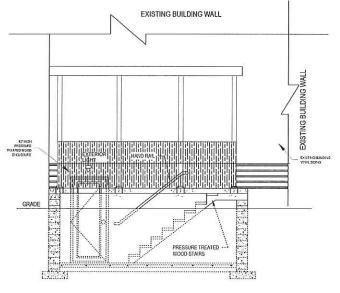
BELOW GRADE ENTRANCE PLAN
