APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIANCE

WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by **ROBERT AND MAGDALENA LAMOUREUX**, **NORMAND AND ROSEMARIA LAMOUREUX** under Section 45 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from **By-law 270-2004**;

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described Part of Lots 3 and 4, Plan Tor 11 municipally known as **7593 CREDITVIEW ROAD**, Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicants are requesting the following variance(s) associated with the proposed severed parcel under consent application B-2022-0012:

- 1. To permit a lot width of 6.8 metres whereas the by-law requires a minimum lot width of 30 metres;
- 2. To permit a side yard setback of 5.02m (16.47 ft.) whereas the by-law requires a minimum side yard setback of 7.5m (24.60 ft.);
- To permit an accessory structure (existing frame shed) having side yard setbacks of 1.0m (3.28 ft.) and 0.0m whereas the by-law requires a minimum setback of 1.2m (3.94 ft.) to the nearest lot line for an accessory structure;
- 4. To permit two (2) accessory structures in the front yard whereas the by-law prohibits accessory structures in the front yard;
- 5. To permit two (2) accessory structures with individual sizes of 50.22 sq. m (540.56 sq. ft.) and 98.87 sq. m (1,064.23 sq. ft.) for a combined area of 149.09 sq. m (1,604.79 sq. ft.) whereas the by-law permits an individual accessory structure with a maximum area of 23 sq. m (247.57 sq. ft.) and a maximum combined area of 40 sq. m (430.56 sq. ft.).


