WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by **ANURAG SHUKLA AND RASHI GUPTA** under Section 45 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from **By-law 270-2004**;

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described as Part of Lot 170, Plan M-1403, Part 16, Plan 43R-25758 municipally known as **85 STARHILL CRESCENT**, Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicant is requesting the following variance(s):

- 1. To permit a below grade entrance within a required interior side yard whereas the by-law does not permit stairways constructed below established grade within a required interior side yard;
- 2. To permit an interior side yard setback of 0.11m (0.36 ft.) to a below grade entrance whereas the by-law requires a minimum interior side yard setback of 1.2m (3.94 ft.).

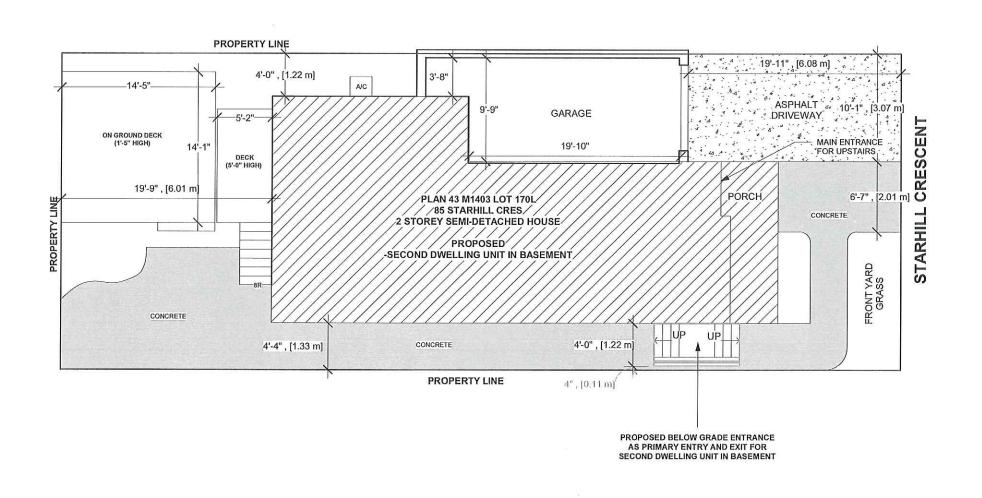

You will be contacted by the City Clerk's Office before the hearing date to confirm your attendance. Confirmation of in-person attendance will be subject to any in-person capacity limits that may be in place for Council Chambers at City Hall and prevailing public health orders and guidance.

If a party does not submit a request and does not participate in the hearing, the Committee may proceed without a party's participation and the party will not be entitled to any further notice regarding the proceeding.

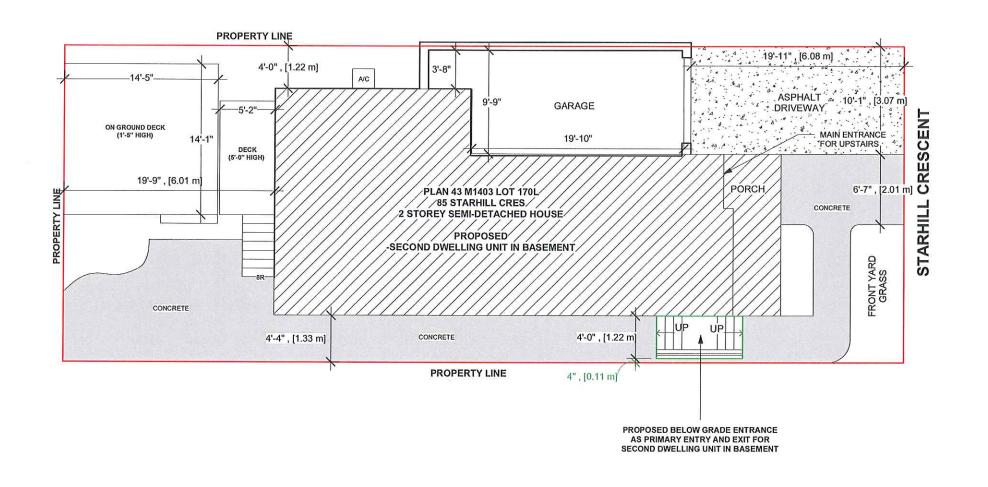
