WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by **NAWRAJ SINHA AND KAPOOR SINHA** under Section 45 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from **By-law 270-2004**;

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described as Part of Lot 339, Plan 43M-1720, Part 32, Plan 43R-31813 municipally known as **138 FANDANGO DRIVE**, Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicants are requesting the following variance(s):

- To permit a below grade entrance between the main wall of a dwelling and the flankage lot line whereas the by-law does not permit a below grade entrance between the main wall of a dwelling and the flankage lot line;
- 2. To permit an exterior side yard setback of 2.9m (9.51 ft.) to a proposed below grade entrance whereas the by-law requires a minimum exterior side yard setback of 3.0m (9.84 ft.);
- 3. To permit a 4.2m (13.78 ft.) separation distance between a driveway and the point of intersection of two streets whereas the by-law requires a minimum 6.0m (19.68 ft.) separation distance between a driveway and projected point of intersection of two streets.

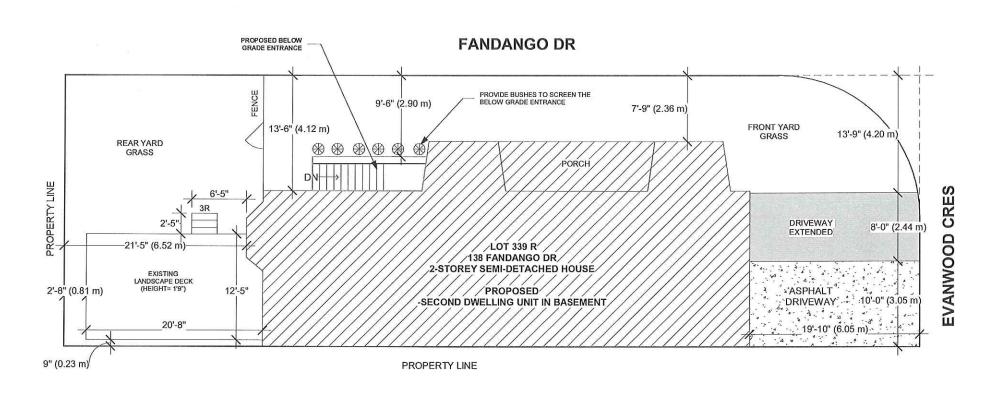

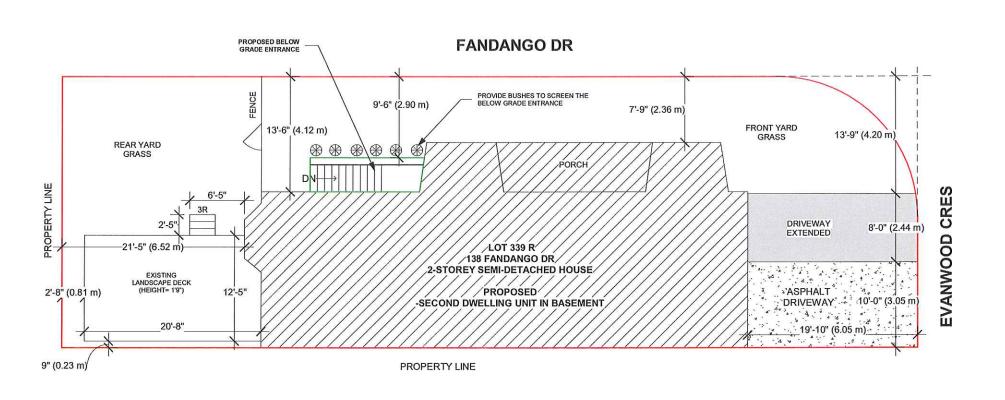
