APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIANCE

WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by **PAVAN BASSI AND ANJULA AHLUWALIA** under Section 45 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from **By-law 270-2004**;

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described as Lot 89, Plan 970 municipally known as **120 LINKDALE ROAD**, Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicants are requesting the following variance(s):

- 1. To permit 2 parking spaces with a depth of 5.19m (17.03 ft.) whereas the by-law requires a minimum depth of 5.4m (17.72 ft.);
- 2. To permit lot coverage of 33.88% whereas the by-law permits a maximum lot coverage of 30%;
- To permit an existing accessory structure having a rear yard setback of 0.42m (1.38 ft.) whereas the by-law requires a minimum setback of 0.6m (1.97 ft.) for an accessory structure to the nearest property lines.

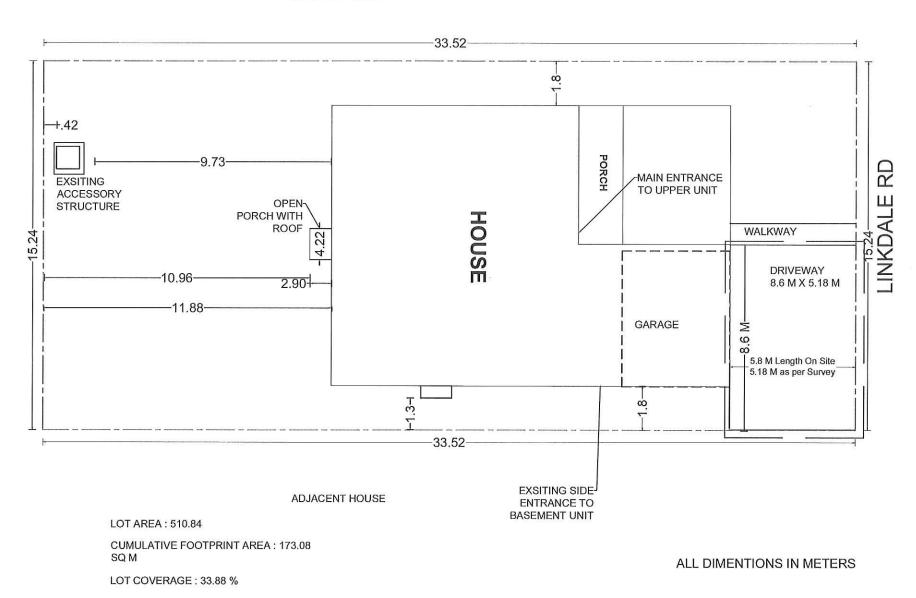

This is in reference to minor variance application submitted for driveway length for 120 Linkdale Rd, Brampton.

In addition to minor variance for driveway length, we seek minor variance related to set back for existing accessory structure in rear yard of the property. Onsite accessory structure is .42 m from rear property line where as as per by law required set back is .6 m from rear property line. Please grant minor variance related to setback for accessory structure from required .6 m to .42 m as per on site.

In addition to above, minor variance related to increase of lot coverage from permitted 30% to existing 33.88% may also be granted. Existing lot coverage of 33.88% is mentioned on site plan attached.
