Hope you're doing well

I am a concerned resident currently living within the property subject to the proposed application. I reside at Versailles Cres. which backs onto the property requested for amendment. I understand that this land is currently zoned residential and places of worship are compatible with the land use but the amount of traffic this will cause additional to the current mess along Highway 50 is the biggest issue.

Aside from removing the much-needed vegetation and green space in this area, the unwanted traffic to this already condensed region would be horrifying. What used to take 10 minutes to get to the highway now takes more than double time with all the trucks transporting from the industrial buildings along highway 50.

Bellchase (a one-lane street each way) is also sometimes used by residents for street parking. The road is already tight as is and barely enough space to get by to Clarkway/Highway 50, imagine how the proposed building/parking would negatively impact this even more.

This trail (that is proposed to be used as the main access point to the building) is often used for quiet hikes for residents looking for a quick escape within the area which would now be taken away from us! Kids being able to safely play on the secluded Clarkway Drive will no longer have ability to do so.

Instead of trying to aid and better the current traffic safety of children and residents in the area, this proposal will only add more unwanted chaos, noise and litter. A place of worship and the unnecessary attention drawn from such an establishment is unwarranted in a location like this.

In conclusion, I along with many other residents within the area, STRONGLY oppose this application and ask that you please consider our concerns and safety prior to any decision being made.
