Hi Shannon,

The Ontario government is currently consulting on a proposal to integrate A Place to Grow and the Provincial Policy Statement into a new province-wide planning policy instrument via an Environmental Registry of Ontario posting at this [link](#). The commenting period ends on December 30, 2022. Following the conclusion of the consultation and engagement with Indigenous communities, the government would determine next steps based on the feedback received. To clarify, the timing for release and implementation of a new province-wide planning policy instrument is not yet known.

With respect to the changes related to upper-tier planning responsibilities through Bill 23, those changes will come into force on a future date to be named through proclamation. At this time, Ministry staff are not aware of the date of proclamation of the Bill.
