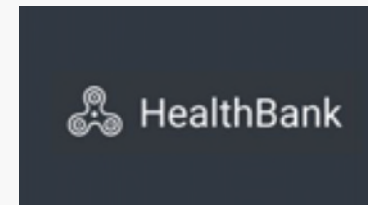
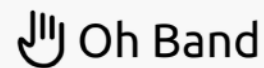
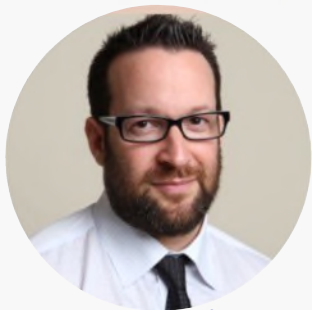
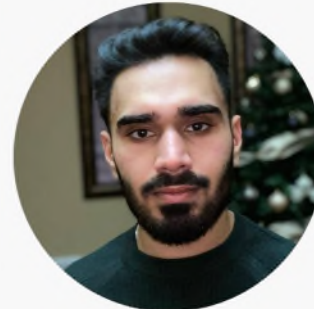
About BVZ

Tenomix's mission is to develop novel technologies that target inefficiencies in the pathology workflow; thus enabling clinicians to make better-informed treatment decisions

- This work is a tribute to Saumik's aunt, who passed away from improper cancer staging

Major updates and highlights:

- Since incorporating (July 2021), they have developed their alpha prototype, formed a patent-pending application on their technology, actively engaged with numerous pathology laboratories for customer discovery interviews and early prototype feedback, and have conducted 18 pre-clinical (animal tissues) and 15 clinical validation experiments (human tissues) with the alpha prototype.

Community Impact



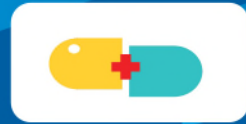
