

# **Engagement Insights**



#### **Current State Insights**

- 1. Brampton Library has many strengths and resources. Community members and staff express that the Library is performing at a high level.
- 2. Library staff are very engaged but are looking for more supports and opportunities.
- Brampton community needs are outpacing current supports and services, especially in response to the growing size and diversity of the city.
- 4. The Brampton community values equity, diversity, inclusion and safety—however some feel these values are being challenged.

#### **Future State Insights**

- 1. People see opportunities to design the Library's physical spaces to be dynamic and responsive to different community needs.
- 2. The Library is seen as a trusted community hub and "defender of the commons."
- 3. Engaging with community members and external partners can help the Library meet more community needs.
- 4. The Library can increase capacity by creating more opportunities for staff engagement and progression.
- 5. The Library's use of digital tools and technology needs to be scaled to better engage with the community.
