Summary of Concerns - Professional Opinion

- 1. Incompatibility** with the Adjacent Neighbourhood.
- 2. No Approval** from Neighbourhood Residents.
- 3. Traffic** : Serious concerns
- 4. BRT proposal**: Serious concerns
- 5. No Proximity to Essential Services**
- 6. Stormwater Management/ infrastructure** issues.

Summary of Concerns - Professional Opinion

7. Environmentally sensitive area : Endangered Species Habitat

8. Schools : No adequate space.

9. Affordable housing claim: No evidence.

10. Squeezing sensitive infills with high density : Bad planning today can affect future Brampton adversely.

11. Specific urban design guidelines : No reference demonstrated during assessment of proposals.
