Recommendations:

Overview:

- By Administrative Authority By-law 216-2017, authority is delegated to department heads to execute certain real estate transactions.
- In order to keep City Council apprised on the quantity and financial implications of agreements executed by administrative authority, Realty Services provides City Council with a summary of each executed agreements, attached to this report as Appendix "A" Summary of Real Estate Transactions executed by Administrative Authority.
- This report provides information on Real Estate Agreements executed by administrative authority for June 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022. This summary does not include agreements arising as a condition of development (site plan/subdivision/consent) approval.

Background:

In accordance with the Administrative Authority By-law, authority is delegated to department heads to execute certain real estate Agreements. Authority is granted for routine, non-controversial transactions up to specified dollar amounts.

Realty Services typically reports to Council on a quarterly basis, on the Real Estate Activities authorized by Administrative Authority attached to this report as Appendix "A" – Summary of Real Estate Transactions executed under the Administrative Authority. However, due to the City Council Election in Q4 2022, this report's timeline was impacted. In future, Realty Staff will be providing this report on a quarterly basis to the Council.

Previously, Realty Staff provided an Information Report to Committee of Council on June 22, 2022, for all transactions completed based on the Administrative Authority By-law for the period from January 1, 2022 to May 31, 2022. Hence the new Information Report is to complete the reporting, for all Real Estate Agreements executed under the Administrative Authority By-law for the remainder of the year, from June 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.
