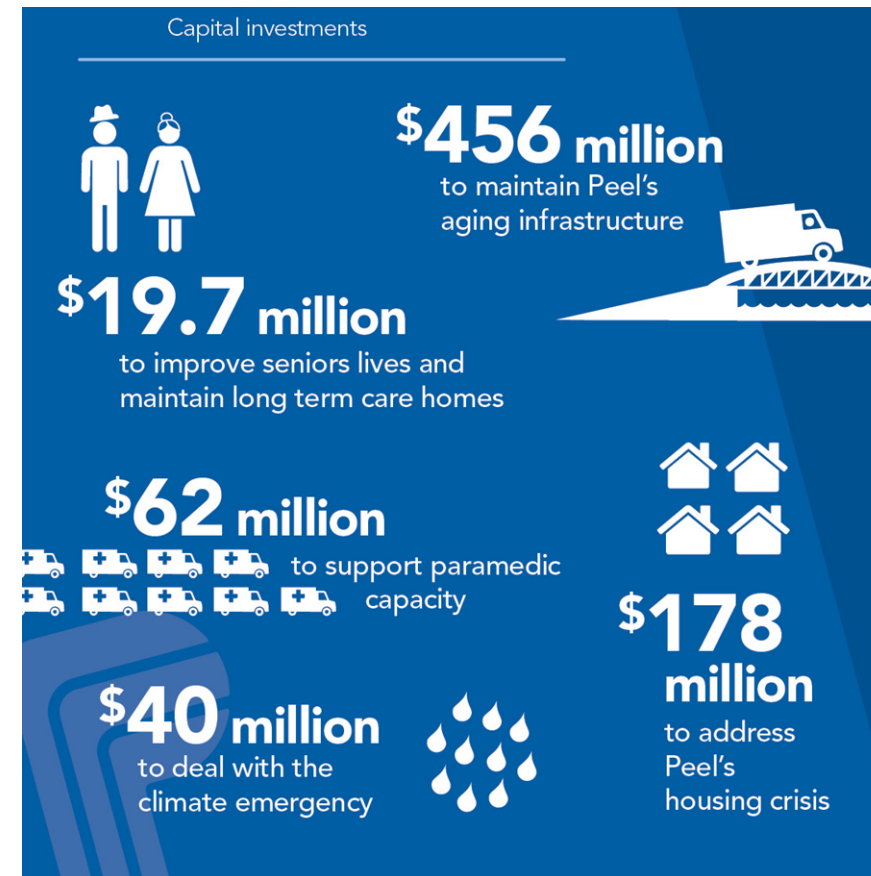

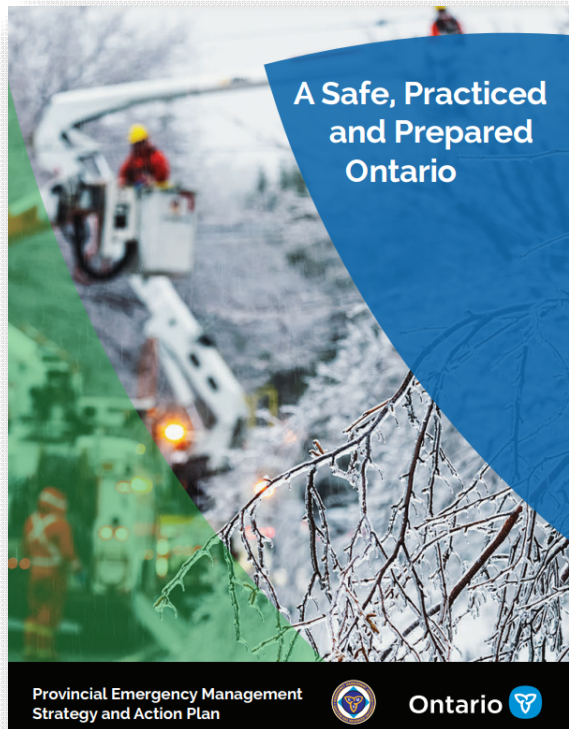
## 2023 Region of Peel Budget

- Investments of \$5B to maintain current service levels for a growing population, while addressing priority community needs.
- Increased investment in **public safety (PRP)** through the addition of 70 uniformed officers, and capital investments to replace infrastructure, vehicles and equipment, expansion of facilities and advancing technological innovation.
- The Wilkinson Road Men's Shelter Redevelopment to reduce street homelessness (\$23.7M).
- Stabilization of Public Health service delivery to sustain immunization services.

### **February 3, 2023: Announced the Provincial Emergency Management Strategy and Action Plan**

- The plan highlights key actions the province is taking to keep Ontario in a state of constant readiness and preparedness.
- Outlines initiatives to augment and support municipal and First Nations emergency strategies.

### 2023 City of Brampton Pre-Budget Submissions

- Federal and Provincial 2023 Pre-Budget consultation are ongoing seeking stakeholder and public comments for the upcoming 2023 budget documents.
- The deadline for formal submissions is February 10, 2023.
- Staff have worked to prepare the City of Brampton submission advocating for key priorities:
  - Infrastructure & Transit
  - Housing
  - Health Care
  - Climate Action
  - Economic Development



### Natural Resources Canada

February 3, 2023

- Through the *Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure Program* the Federal government will contribute \$1.7M to support installation of 164 Level 2 EV chargers and 12 Level 3 fast chargers in Brampton.
- Funding breakdown:
  - \$1,720,000 from NRCan
  - \$8,692,068 from the City of Brampton

- Meeting with Members of the Brampton City Council to discuss the City of Brampton's pre-budget submission and city priorities.
- Discussion to continue the productive working relationship between the two levels of government.
