## Summary of Concerns - Professional Opinion

- 1. Incompatibility with the Adjacent Neighbourhood.
- 2. No Approval from Neighbourhood Residents.
- 3. Traffic: Serious concerns
- 4. BRT proposal: Serious concerns
- 5. No Proximity to Essential Services
- 6. Stormwater Management/ infrastructure issues.

#### Summary of Concerns - Professional Opinion

- 7. Environmentally sensitive area: Endangered Species Habitat
- 8. Schools: No adequate space.
- 9. Affordable housing claim: No evidence.
- **10. Squeezing sensitive infills with high density:** Bad planning today can affect future Brampton adversely.
- 11. Specific urban design guidelines: No reference demonstrated during assessment of proposals.



In Sept 2022 meeting, The Council recommended further consultation with the Residents, Developers and City Planners. CVRA met with both developers and expressed concerns but concerns were not addressed.

Decision rests on the Mayor and all the Councillors.

We urge and hope that you all make a choice keeping in mind that Sustainability and Development should go hand in hand. We cannot sacrifice one for the other.
