APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIANCE

WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by **PAWAN KUMAR AND BALVINDER KUMAR** under Section 45 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from **By-law 270-2004**;

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described as Lot 60, Plan M-1944 municipally known as **8 ALLEGRO DRIVE**, Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicants are requesting the following variance(s):

1. To permit a deck encroachment of 3.17m (10.40 ft) into the required rear yard, resulting in a rear yard setback of 4.33m (14.21 ft) whereas the by-law permits a maximum deck encroachment of 1.8m (5.91 ft) resulting in a rear yard setback of 5.7m (18.70 ft).

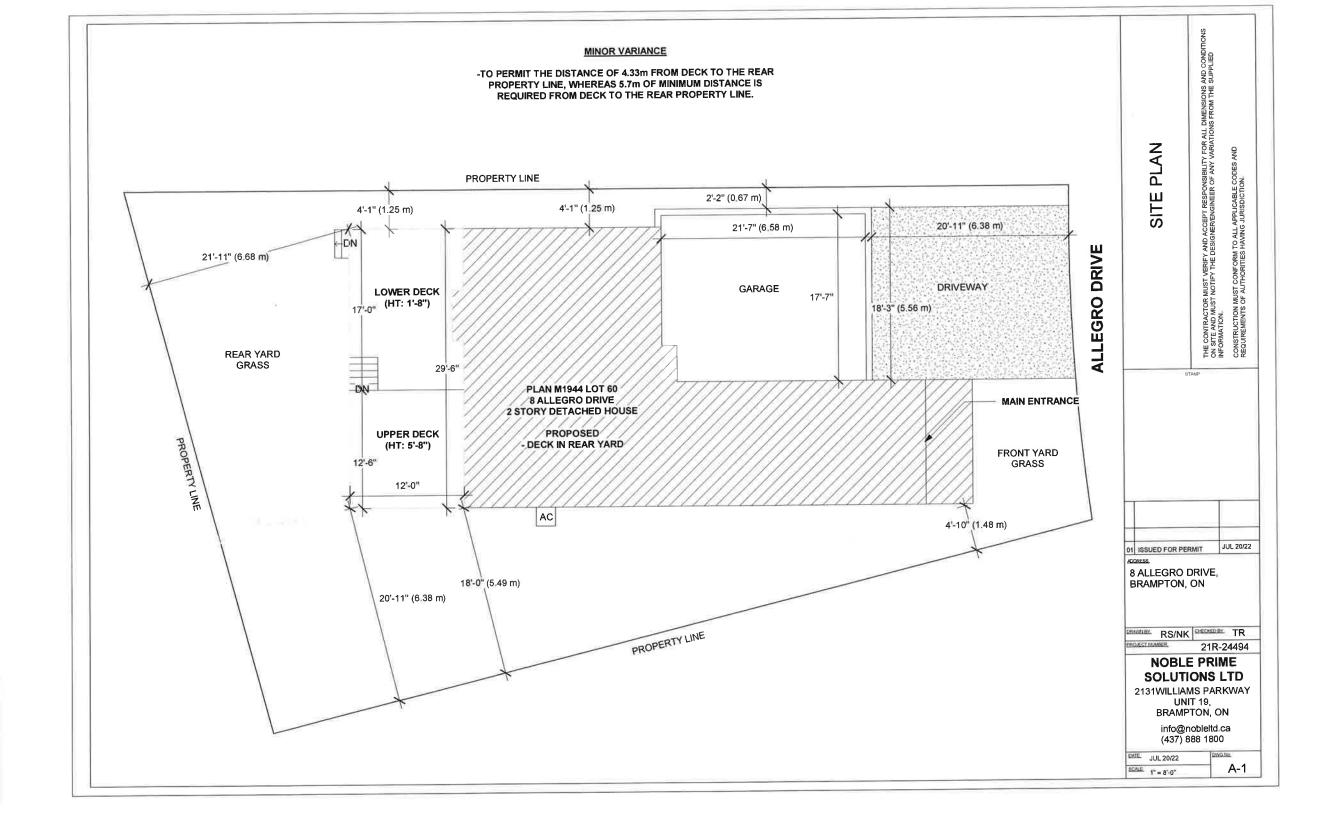
