As you are aware, third-party advertising refers to advertisements or other materials that support, promote or oppose a candidate, or support, promote or oppose a "yes" or "no" answer to a question on the ballot. Activities that do not involve spending money, such as discussions or expressing an opinion about a candidate (or an answer to a question on the ballot) are not considered to be third-party advertising.

Municipal elections are an important part of our local democracy. The Ministry reviews the municipal election process following each municipal election to ensure it continues to meet the needs of Ontario communities. I value hearing the views of candidates, voters, and municipal staff as they reflect on their election experience.
