WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by **DOUGLAS WRIGHT AND DIANE WRIGHT** under Section 45 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from **By-law 270-2004**;

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described as Part of Lots 55 and 56, Plan BR-32 municipally known as **18 ROSEDALE AVENUE WEST,** Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicants are requesting the following variance(s):

1. To permit a rear yard setback of 3.6m (11.82 ft) to a proposed 1 storey addition (sunroom) whereas the by-law requires a minimum rear yard setback of 8.05m (24.41 ft).
