

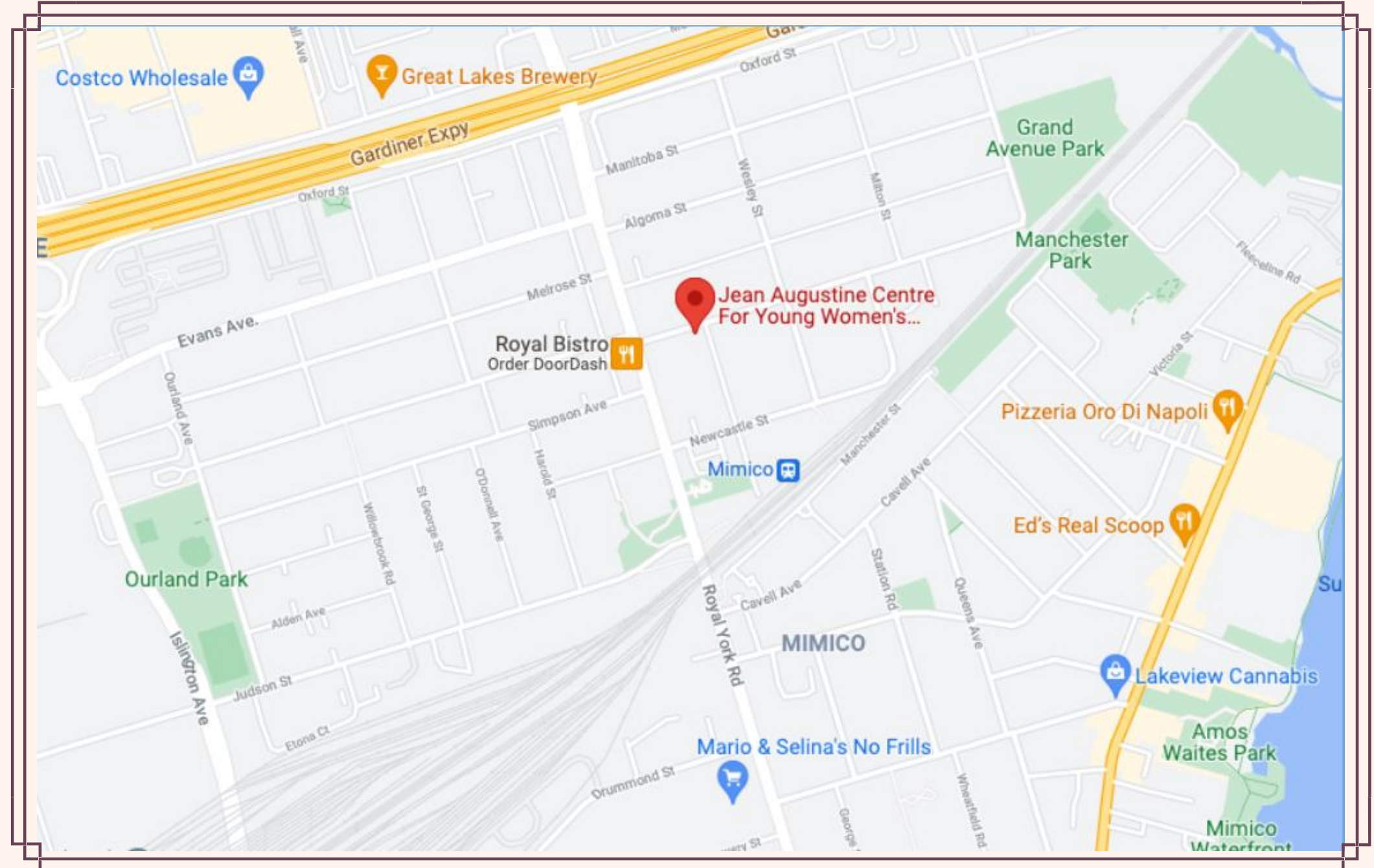

Hon. Dr. Jean Augustine P.C., C.M., O.Ont., C.B.E.

First African-Canadian woman to be elected to the House of Commons.

- Elected in the Etobicoke-Lakeshore riding in 1993, sitting in Parliament until 2006.
- Appointed by the Government of Ontario as Fairness Commissioner, a position created to advocate for Canadians with foreign credentials.
- Was part of the leading motions that allowed for the placement of the Famous Five statue on Parliament Hill in Ottawa, and the creation of Black History Month in Canada.

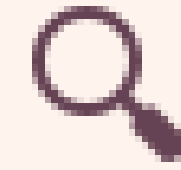
