WHEREAS an application for minor variance has been made by **MICHAEL THALACHIRAYIL AND NIMMY GEORGE NEDUMKALLEL** under Section 45 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13) for relief from **By-law 270-2004**:

AND WHEREAS the property involved in this application is described as Lot 54, Plan M-353 municipally known as **23 SCHUBERT CRESCENT,** Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the applicant is requesting the following variance(s):

- 1. To permit an existing above grade door in the side wall where a minimum side yard width 0.95m (3.12 ft) is provided extending from the front wall of the dwelling up to and including the door whereas the by-law does not permit a door in the side wall unless there is a minimum side yard width of 1.2m (3.94 ft.) extending from the front wall of the dwelling up to and including the door;
- 2. To permit a 0.95m (3.12 ft) path of travel leading to the primary entrance to a second unit whereas the bylaw requires an unencumbered side yard with of 1.2m (3.94 ft.) to be provided as a path of travel from the front yard to the entrance to the second unit.

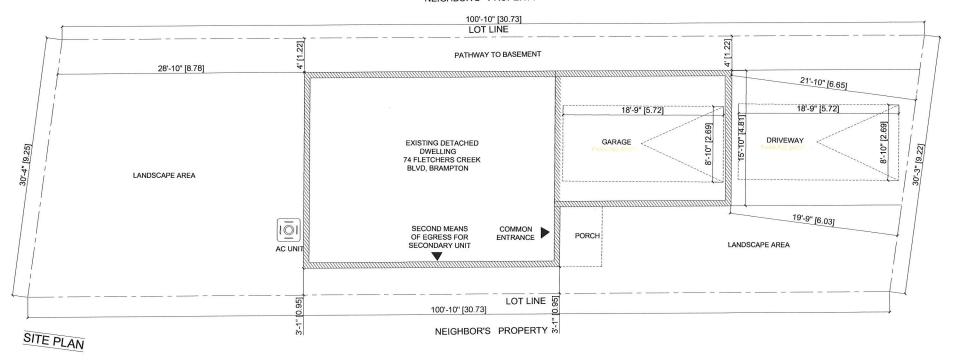

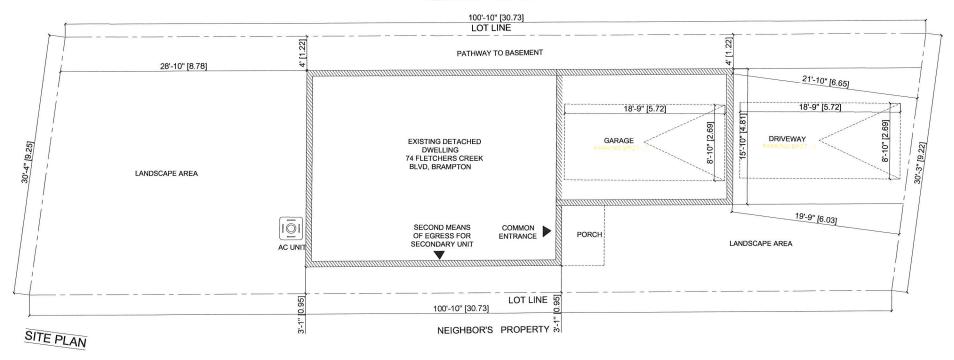
