Overview:

- The City of Brampton's 50th birthday celebrations will take place throughout 2024, with both city-wide initiatives and events led by City departments.
- A large 'Brampton Birthday Celebration' will take place on June 29, 2024 at Chinguacousy Park.
- Utilizing a broad internal consultation of staff leaders, the theme for the celebrations will be *Chapter 50: Telling the story of Brampton's past, present & future.*
- The City's Corporate logo will be changed to gold for the duration of 2024. The new logo will be used in communications, programming, events, and other City initiatives pertaining to the 50th birthday celebrations

Background:

The City of Brampton will be marking its 50th birthday (since incorporation) on January 1, 2024.

From a settlement in the early 1800s, to an officially designated city in 1974, Brampton has grown into a dynamic and vibrant city with a proud past and bright future.

Brampton is Canada's 9th largest city, moving from a small population of 500 in 1853 to 656,480 in 2021. It is the fastest growing of Canada's largest 25 cities, and Brampton's growth represents 90.2% of the net population growth within the Region of Peel (between 2016 and 2021). We are a diverse community with 250 cultures speaking 171 languages.

To commemorate the 50 successful and vibrant years of Brampton's growth, various city-wide initiatives and events will be led by City departments, including a dedicated website highlighting celebrations and a special one-year City logo rebrand.

Through a cross departmental working group, staff engaged various internal and external stakeholders to develop and implement a work plan that utilizes the theme of *Chapter 50: Telling the story of Brampton's past, present and future.*

Current Situation:

Work Plan Overview

The City of Brampton's 50th birthday celebrations are founded on the theme of *Chapter 50: Telling the story of Brampton's past, present & future.*

Celebrations will begin on December 31, 2023, at our annual New Year's Eve event, and continue throughout the year including, but not limited to, the 2024 Levee, Citizens Awards and Brampton Birthday Celebration. To celebrate this golden jubilee milestone, we will be changing the City's logo to gold and incorporating it in all 2024 promotional material.

A Brampton's 50th Birthday Visual Identity Guide (Appendix 1) will guide all year-long marketing and promotional material.

Brampton's 50th celebrations will be executed through new initiatives and existing programs and events; details are available in Brampton's 50th Birthday Work Plan (Appendix 2). Proposed initiatives for the celebrations include:

- Transit bus wraps
- 50th photo opportunity in Ken Whillans Square
- Traveling exhibition display highlighting Brampton's 50 years, in partnership with PAMA
- The Citizens Awards introducing a special 50th category to highlight individuals and organizations that have been instrumental to the development of Brampton
- Memorabilia/swag giveaways at events
- Brampton Birthday Celebration on June 29, 2024, which will include stage performances, family-friendly programming and a City showcase
