Family & Intimate Partner Violence In Peel

Highest number of police calls are for family and intimate partner violence related

3 out of 5 of the most frequent incidents reported are family and intimate partner violence-related

51% Increase for counselling services for women dealing with violence

2 in 5 murders are domestic violence incidents

65% Increase in women requesting transitional and housing support

- Individual and group counselling
- Wellness, self-esteem and parenting programs Financial literacy, education & legal/advocacy support

- Housing & rental assistance
