Our charity is dedicated to empowering these young individuals and providing them with the tools and resources they need to thrive and succeed in all aspects of life.

Outcome and Results

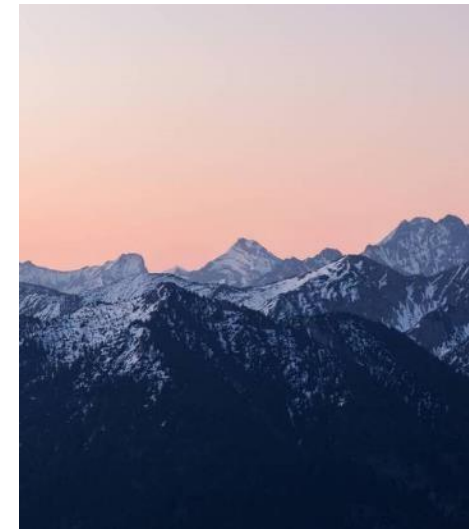
