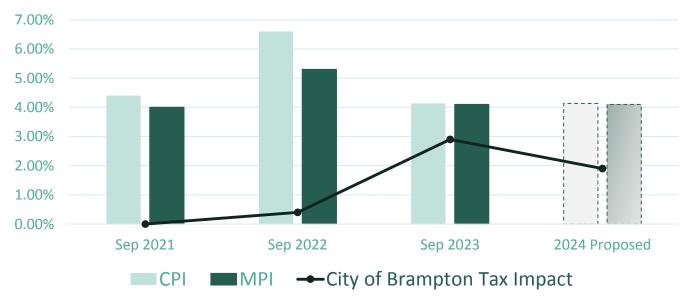

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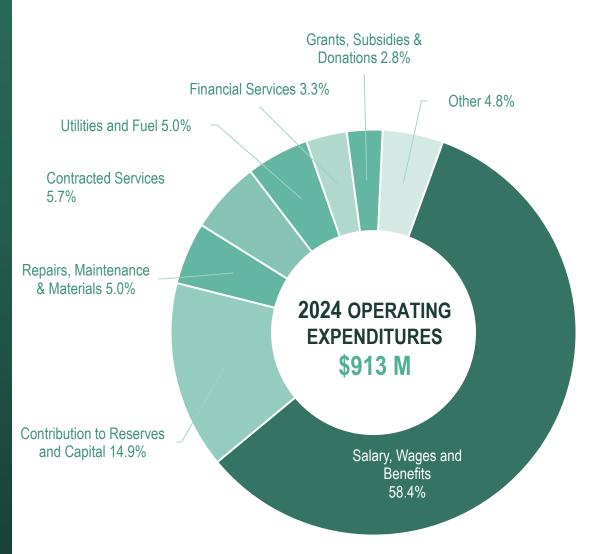

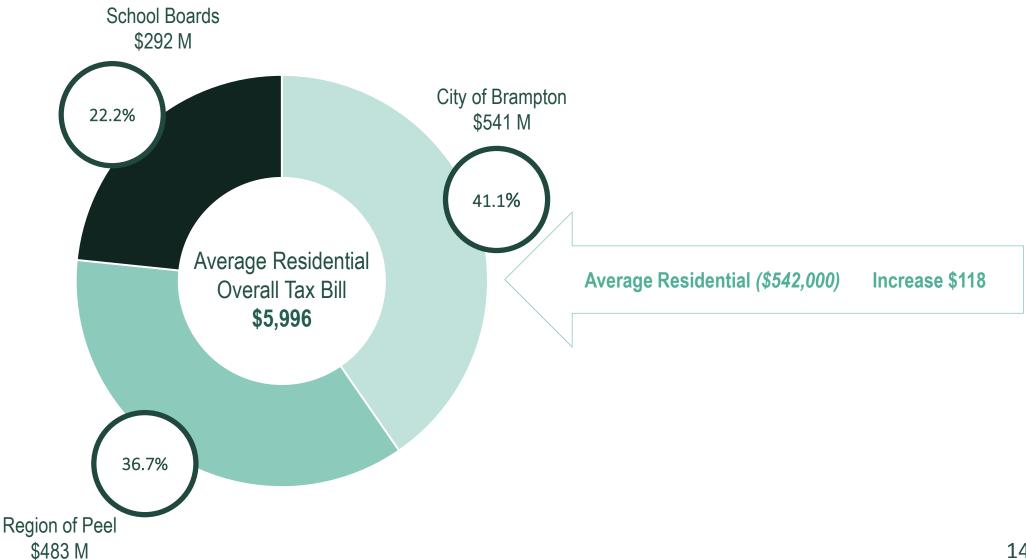

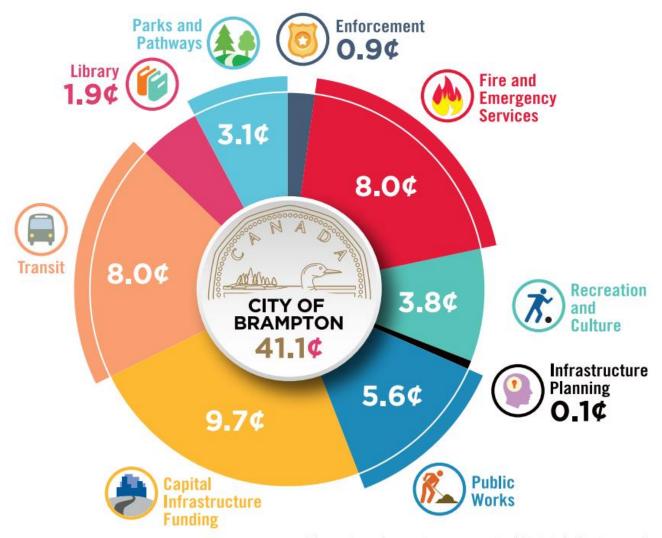

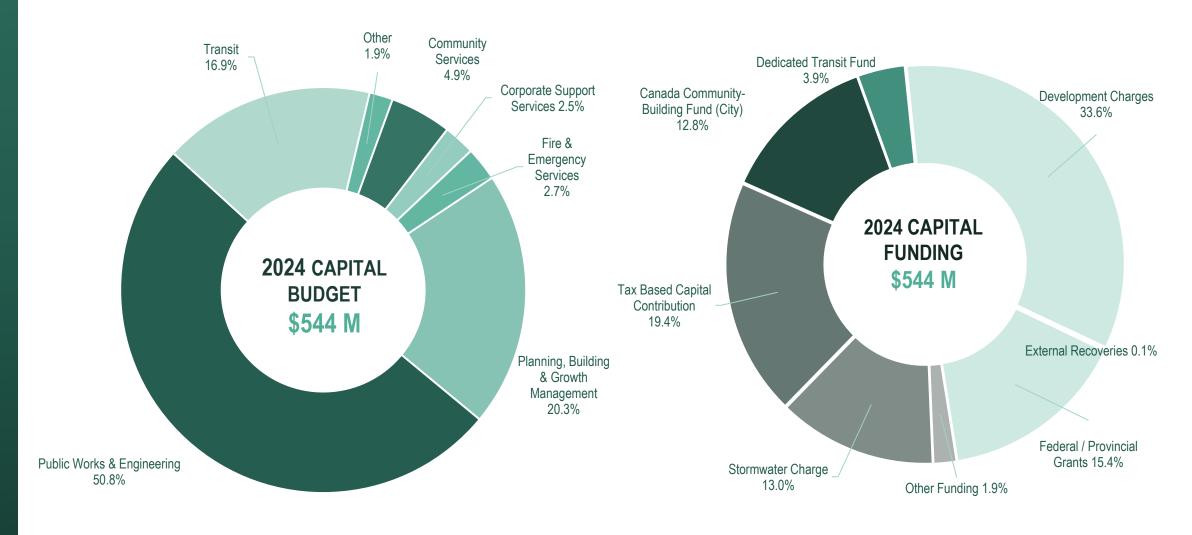
### Components of a Brampton Tax Bill



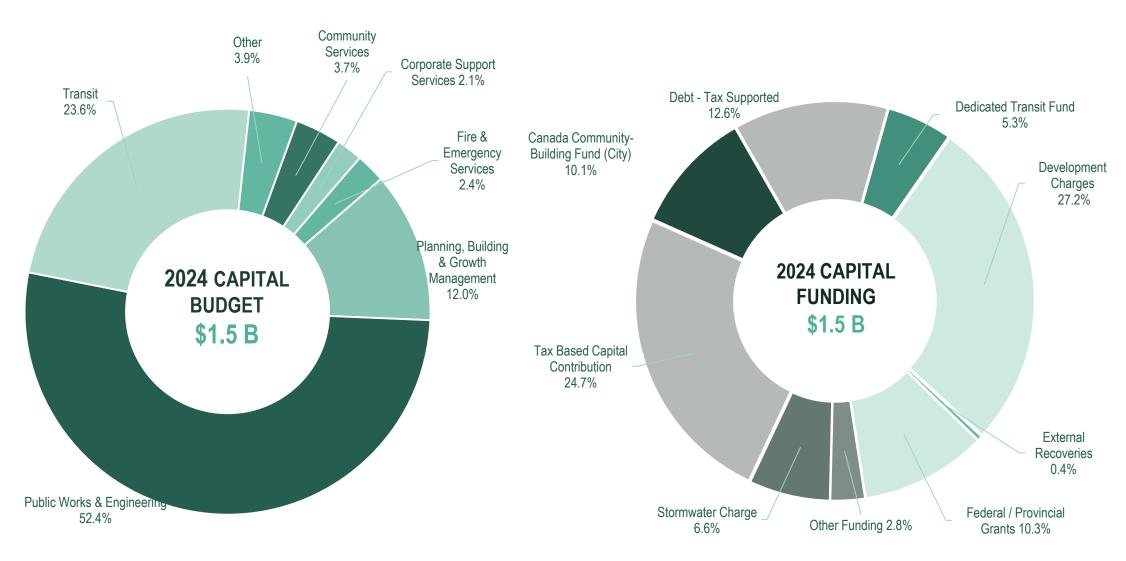
### Allocation of Taxes by Service



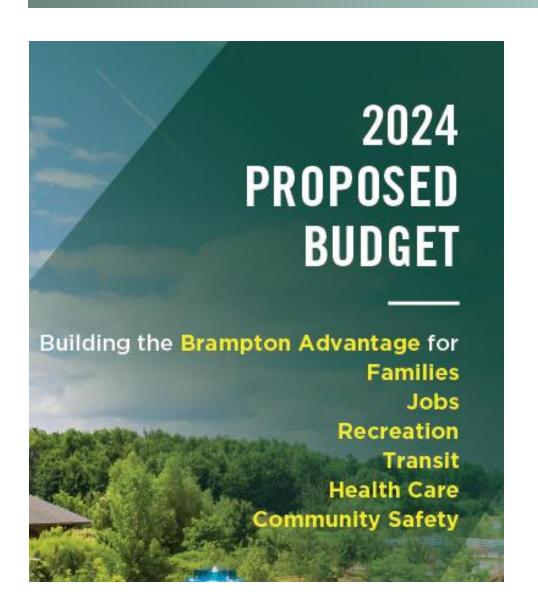
