

REVENUE OPPORTUNITIES

PROJECT REVENUE OPPORTUNITY The 2024 Budget proposes startup revenues of \$3.5M from ASE operations, fully offset by **ASE Ticket** equivalent expenditures, for a net zero impact to the property tax base. **Processing** Centre **50 Cameras – Continuous Operation** Over a 5-year period, ASE operations are projected to generate annual positive cash flow in the range of \$3M to \$5M, net of expenditures. • This revenue projection would result in a breakeven point of 11-25 years, where the City would fully repay capital investments in land, building and equipment. 185 Cameras – Continuous Operation Over a 5-year period, ASE operations are projected to generate annual positive cash flow in the range of \$7M to \$17M, net of expenditures. • This revenue projection would result in a breakeven point of 3-6 years, where the City would fully repay capital investments in land, building and equipment.

Carbon Credits	 The value of the traded global markets for carbon dioxide (CO2) credits is estimated at almost \$1 trillion in 2022. The City of Brampton is in the process of acquiring a consultant through a Request for Proposal to provide consulting services to quantify the City of Brampton's carbon footprint and reductions, and develop a Carbon Offset and Credit Strategy for the City. The consultant will determine the Carbon Offset and Credit Strategy which may generate revenue streams through the creation of carbon credits from GHG reductions in: Retrofits and energy efficiency in buildings, Electrification of Fleets/Vehicles, Installation of EV Charging Stations. The city will have a more fulsome understanding of the potential revenue from our carbon reduction items in the coming months.
